It has a rustic appearance, which I really like, and a little yard with real grass (rare here). *Please pray that we can get our kids enrolled in a good local school very soon!* I just got most of our stuff out of storage, so now there are boxes all over the place. The local phone company is working on putting in this community's telephone and internet lines, so I haven't been able to get our house connected yet. Until everything is set up, I still have to do all my computer work at McDonald's!



Meanwhile, our port outreach project in Marseille has been going well, and more Operation Transit teams are arriving in Spain and in Italy. The summer's first evangelism teams have just arrived here in Algeciras, and on their first foray, they already saw four people decide to accept and follow Jesus as their Lord and Savior! *Please keep praying that God works in and through the lives of all our mission project staff and volunteers, and that God's Word would be received and read by tens of thousands of North Africans this summer.* Thank you!
